	3) pave the way for sound impact assessment of reduction measures.
	Öko-Institut was commissioned to study existing literature, focusing its
	attention on three European seas, i.e. North Sea, Baltic Sea and the
	Mediterranean. All the available studies regarding land-sourced litter
	were collected and analysed. In order to develop a scientifically founded
	basis for taking specific measures to avoid further dumping, this
	particular factor was closely examined.
	The report has not considered other factors, such as ecological impact,
	the part that legislation has to play, or the significance of education and
	behavior.
