#### **ENGLISH VERSION**

#### **Short Summary**

By plunging in « Troubled Waters » the user will explore a universe of possibilities, but also of problems and blocades, when groups and individuals are faced with the problems of waste, and marine litter. The mindmap will entice him to choose his own path to engage in finding solutions, and participate in a collective effort to change behaviors of all.

## **Summary**

634,000 kilograms of waste are dumped into the oceans each second, 20 billion tonnes per year, of which 80% come from land! Well, what can we do?

We cannot hide from the fact that this enormous amount of waste littering the bottom of our seas and oceans come from us, from our actions as well as our inactions. What steps can we take to curb this scourge, and how can we find real solutions in our practices and laws to better manage our waste?

Troubled Waters questions us, we Europeans, on our ability to change our behaviour towards waste. For two years, filmmaker Isabelle Sylvestre travelled across Europe in order to meet different groups and individuals who are all part of the waste management system. From the door-to-door service to explain recycling, to the large "indecision" of our national and European politics; from the management of "green" ports, or the visit to a very special school of young fishermen, to the emergence of collective good practices, and the impact of the economic crisis on waste management, Isabelle Sylvestre encountered Europeans, who in their own way, try to change things - or not.

This multimedia work consists of footage filmed "live", in a "cinéma vérité" style. By navigating through the mindmap of *Troubled Waters*, we are invited to explore new ways of treating the problem, but also confront our resistance to change. Thus, each one of us will draw his or her own path by trying to answer his or her own questions. And, if desired, make choices of concrete actions, to participate in a collective effort to change.

*Troubled Waters* is an interactive journey that shows real facts, their consequences and the possibilities of change. Translated into seven languages, it aims to confront citizens across Europe with their own role in the fight against one of the greatest ecological disasters of this millennium.

#### **Director's Biography**

Isabelle Sylvestre is a sociologist of the new media and the new technologies (Centre Edgar Morin / Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales EHESS) and director of documentary films. She worked on the conceptualization of unpublished Web tools of creation. Directly inspired of the theory of "complex thinking", these collaborative Webfilms allow the meeting of arts, sciences, and knowledge.

As a filmmaker, Isabelle Sylvestre worked nearly a decade in France, especially for the Franco-Belgian program StripTease (documentary) for the channel France 3. She has directed several reports and documentaries in various countries particularly in the Middle East, but also in Europe and in North America. She currently teaches documentary film writing.
